Count, inspect and catalog medical devices for 6 clinics, using ATMS' Chronolnventory Software, as to provide accurate data & real time inventory of each clinic's instruments. Provide each clinic with a well-documented audit report benchmarking them with Accreditation Canada's reprocessing norms.

The Feedback

ATMS provided us with insight into the size, the quality and the quantity of the medical device inventory used at the four community clinics.

Once we implemented ATMS' recommendations, we improved the scheduling of our workload and standardized the medical devices, leading to considerable cost savings for the Hospital and the clinics that use our sterilization facilities.
